



Even clearly not all can win an award, it is a big recognition just to be nominated and to be part of the event and making it in the finals, which we are happy to say we did this year!


The event is organized by several persons but the key person is Jennean Bates and we are grateful to her for the arrangement, which was flawless.

## Hydro Audit at Shanxi Jinyang Carbon Co., Ltd.

By the first half of 2014 it was decided by Hydro that they would require an "updated inspection and audit" of our carbon sidewall producer in China, Shanxi Jinyang Carbon. The previous inspection took place in 2009 when we received the quality acceptance for the Qatalum Project.

The Hydro people involved in this updated inspection in August this year were Sverre Enger, Svein Kåre Sund and Jun Liang. As this was a full and complete inspection/audit, Hydro also included both people from the HSE and CSR department, André Fey and Thomas Knutzen, respectively.

A complete plant tour from receipt of raw materials to the final production and to packing on pallets and crates was arranged with a full discussion afterwards on the Hydro findings and comments and with Shanxi providing various documentation for each production process. There has been a huge improvement at the plant since the last visit and this was also acknowledged by Hydro. At the end of the inspection we were informed that Shanxi Jinyang Carbon had been approved as an "A" supplier to the Hydro group.

Both Shanxi and *simonsen* do appreciate that Hydro takes the time to do full audits, as this is one of the important ways in which we can improve our production processes and thereby our quality. 


